2. William Hinkle, Chair, Ohio Public Safety Communications Joint Task Force

- Presented on the life of SB 5 which eventually led to statutory training standards in Ohio.
- Biggest obstacle to mandatory training was that it was an unfunded mandate. Ohio Municipal League, County Commissioners Association of Ohio major opponents to such a mandate.
- Will speak with Rep. Flowers, OML, and CCAO, to gauge reception to mandatory training requirements.
- Feels that there will be little difficulty in simply updating Ohio training standards to Project 33.
- Original bill will need to be amended, updating the needed areas, while keeping changes to a minimum.
